NJ State Fire Chiefs Awards & Citations Criteria

- a. <u>Department Unit Citation</u>: Awarded to an entire crew assigned to a station or unit for valorous or meritorious action in the line of duty.
- b. <u>Community Service Award:</u> This is for a person, team or organization that improves the quality of life in their community through programs or projects that have a significant impact on their community
- c. <u>Citizen Heroism Award</u>: Presented to individuals who take action under duress or hazardous conditions to perform a remarkable feat or deed.
- d. <u>Community Threat Award</u>: Presented to an individual, team or organization for outstanding service rendered during an emergency. Sample events include, but not limited to - Extreme Weather, Large Scale Event, Or other significant threat to part of, or the community as a whole.
- e. <u>Medical Lifesaving Award</u>: Presented to all members involved with lifesaving actions for a critical patient ill or injured who survives long enough to be released from the hospital.
- f. CHIEF OF THE YEAR Chief Of The Department That Demonstrates Exemplary Leadership
- g. <u>Dispatcher of the Year</u>: Awarded annually to a member for promoting the 911 dispatch center through outstanding character and selfless devotion to the service of others.
- h. <u>Firefighter of the Year</u>: Awarded annually to a member for promoting the Character, Attitude and Values that demonstrates outstanding character and selfless devotion to the service of others.
- i. <u>Letter of Recognition</u>: This award is presented to nominees whose actions are deserving of recognition but do not meet the criteria for the other awards.
- j. <u>Life Saving Medal</u>: Awarded to any team, who acts within their scope of duty, conscious of the danger of risk, personal harm, or hazard, when such an action is believed to have saved the life of another, when that life is in danger. This award formembers of a team perform life saving measures which result in a life saved.
- k. <u>Medal of Valor</u>: Awarded to a member of the department on or off duty who intelligently, conscious of the danger, and at great risk of imminent personal harm or hazard, distinguishes himself or herself by the performance of an act of gallantry and above the call of normal duty
